



## What's New in KnowBrainer 2008

(Due to be released in late August 2008)

**One of the biggest hurdles in KnowBrainer 2007, was the KnowBrainer window freezing after about 45 minutes of use. Although the KnowBrainer global commands were unaffected, the application-specific commands would remain disabled until you closed and re-launched KnowBrainer or said **Refresh KnowBrainer**. This has been eliminated in KnowBrainer 2008 but if that isn't reason enough to upgrade, Continue reading...**

### New Commands

- A number of new powerful commands designed to enable Select-&-Say in all programs (including EMR applications that Nuance is preventing from functioning in all versions of NaturallySpeaking can other than Dragon Medical 10)
- **Color <color>** font color commands for Word XP - 2007 and Outlook 2007. Example: Color Red will change the color of any highlighted word to Red
- **Color <color> Back** will change the color of any highlighted word and move the cursor back to the end of the current paragraph
- **Highlight <color>** will change the highlight color of any highlighted text to the desired color.
- **Save JPEG** – will save a picture of your current Window
- **Capture Screen** – will take a snapshot of your desktop
- **Capture Window** – will take a snapshot of the current Window
- **Capture JPEG**
- **Hibernate**
- **Open Startup** – open System Configuration Utility
- Start Office Programs with simple commands like **Start Word**
- Reintroduction of commands that formally produce double Windows (now that we have a solution)
- Fix **Add to Vocabulary** command
- Easily launch MS Office programs with simple commands like **Start Word/Excel/Access etc...**
- **Start Notepad...**
- **Read Sentence, Read Next or Previous Sentence** - MS Word

- **New Application Command**
- **Underline Button & Underline Button 2**
- **View Folder Options**
- Fixed **Take/Pick/Resume <1To10>** commands for Word
- Fixed **Open <file>** commands to prevent it from opening more than one folder
- **Delete From Vocabulary** will delete any highlighted word or phrase from your vocabulary
- **<Color> Back** – MS Word – Saying Red Back (in Word) will color the highlighted text Red and move the cursor back to the end of the current paragraph in
- **Train** command re-written
- **Quick Train** – utilized by placing the cursor beside (don't highlight) a problem word so that DNS will grab the entire phrase, open Spell Correction, click the **Train** button, click the **Go** button, wait 5 seconds for you to read the text (train) and close the box.
- **Back or Forward 1-5 Windows** – global browser command to move back and forward 1-5 pages
- **Shift Enter 1-100** creates a hard break between 1 and 100 (often used in MS Word when working with Internet Explorer)
- **Line Break** – inserts hard break (often used in MS Word when working with Internet Explorer to distinguish a line break)
- **Paragraph Break** – inserts hard break (often used in MS Word when working with Internet Explorer to distinguish a line break)
- **Middle Click** – mouse middle button click
- **Middle Double Click** – mouse middle button double click
- **Double List A-Z** – Used to create outlines (similar to the **Double List <1-100>** command. If you say **Double List A** the cursor will move to the end of the current paragraph, press {Enter} twice, type **A.** and force the next dictated word to appear capitalized.
- **Double List Small a-z** – Used to create outlines (similar to the **Double List <1-100>** command. If you say **Double List Small A** the cursor will move to the end of the current paragraph, press {Enter} twice, type **(a)** and force the next dictated word to appear capitalized.
- **List A-Z** – same as **Double List A-Z** but presses {Enter} once for single line spacing.
- **List Small a-z** – same as **Double List Small a-z** but presses {Enter} once for single line spacing.
- **Zoom To 100%** – returns browsers to default view
- **<Direction> <1to100> Back** – moves the cursor up, down, left or right 1 to 100 rows or characters and moves the cursor back to the original position. Example: When dictating an e-mail with a tag, it's not always easy to see the last few lines when you get me at the bottom of the page so saying a command like **Down 6 Back** will allow you to view 6 more lines of the document.

- **Fix Line** - removes the unwanted extra space that appears before your first line of dictation when dictating in tables and cells
